Mark Twain drew heavily on satire to comment on American society during the mid-1800s. Throughout Twain's most well known works, *The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn* and *The Adventures of Tom Sawyer*, derision for society's hypocrisies are thinly veiled. Issues such as slavery, religion, and the inherent cruelty in human nature are brought to the surface in humorous, yet powerful ways. Perhaps the example most frequently alluded to is that of Tom Sawyer's treatment of Jim, a former slave. To illustrate the cruelty African-Americans still faced after slavery was abolished, Twain's character, Tom Sawyer, essentially tortures Jim and uses him for his own amusement. It is meant to be ironic that the person cruelest to Jim is neither his owner nor the man who sold him into slavery, but a small boy who exemplifies the racist and prejudiced views held by many Americans at the time.
